This 40-hour Didactic education course has been broken up into segments; March 2nd, 8th, 16th, 22nd, & 30th and all are mandatory attendance for completing the course. This course is designed to provide RNs, APNs and MDs with basic education in providing medical forensic care to adult/adolescent patients of sexual assault/abuse. This course follows the guidelines established by the DOJ and the International Association of Forensic Nurses (IAFN), and will present various hands-on educational opportunities as well as skill stations.

Upon completion of this Didactic Course, the participant will be awarded 40 CEU contact hours. No partial credit will be given, nor will training be recorded. Preceptorship hours are to follow training and will be shared at a later date. This will also be needed for completion.

Note: Completion of the didactic course does not qualify an RN to practice as a SANE. In addition to the didactic portion, clinical requirements must be completed in the participant's community. Additional information will be provided during the course.
